In the spring as you drive to the high desert region of Klamath County you can't help but notice the brilliant wild flowers which spot the landscape between the log pole pine and fir trees. Radiant reds and yellows adorn the birch trees in the fall, and the basin is gleaming with snow in the winter months.
