These "Fly/Drive" itineraries are suggested routes depending on your schedule and interests. The choice is yours.

**PURE OREGON**  
*City lights, rugged coastline, majestic mountain lakes, and high desert sunsets.*

Enjoy two nights in Portland before traveling to Central Oregon, home to the High Desert Museum, world-class golf, and dozens of breweries. The next day, experience Crater Lake, Oregon's only National Park. As you travel to the Rogue Valley for overnight accommodations in Medford, stop at Union Creek and the Natural Bridge Interpretive Area, where the Rogue River goes underground through basalt caves. Evening delights include the famed Oregon Shakespeare Festival in Ashland. The following day, sample the best of Southern Oregon's culinary and wine flavors on a trip through the Applegate Valley, which brings you to Grants Pass for overnight accommodations. Spend the evening jetting on the Rogue River with Hellgate Jetboat Excursions' dinner trip. The next day, enjoy a gorgeous drive on Hwy 199, the Redwood Highway, which brings you to the South Coast. Travel north on Hwy 101 to Brookings, Port Orford, Gold Beach, Coos Bay and Bandon. The following day, take your time and travel along the Umpqua River through the Umpqua Valley Wine Country. Overnight in Roseburg before heading back to Portland.

**PORTLAND TO SAN FRANCISCO & BACK AGAIN**  
*Discover its many terrains.*

This trip combines parts of the above itinerary and adds a Northern California section to the tour. Begin in Portland and travel through the scenic

Willamette Valley wine country, and into Southern Oregon's Umpqua Wine region. Overnight in Roseburg before traveling to the South Coast to enjoy Bandon and Coos Bay. Travel south on Hwy 101 to the Redwood Hwy, traveling west to Grants Pass. This route has amazing photo opportunities! Spend the following day on the Rogue River hiking, fishing, jetboating, or rafting or visit Wildlife Images Rehabilitation Center, which provides care and treatment for sick, injured and orphaned wildlife indigenous to the Pacific NW. The following day, head to Crater Lake National Park, and return to Medford for overnight accommodations. Spend the following day exploring Medford, tour and shop at Harry & David's, sample wines, and see a play at the Oregon Shakespeare Festival. Then, it's off to the Northern California Shasta Cascades before heading to San Francisco. **PORTLAND TO SAN FRANCISCO LOOP** *A recipe for fun!*

This itinerary will take you down the entire Oregon and Northern California Coastline, with suggested overnights in (Oregon) Newport, Coos Bay, Bandon; (California) Eureka, Mendocino, and San Francisco. From San Francisco, travel up I-5 to the Rogue Valley. Spend a couple of days in Medford, the perfect location from which to



experience Southern Oregon wines, culinary creations, tax-free shopping, and amazing golf courses. Then, enjoy a three-day guided trip on the Wild & Scenic Rogue River, an amazing rafting or hiking adventure, with either lodge or camping accommodations. Next, travel to Crater Lake National Park, where you can explore, hike, and even take an interpretive boat ride on the lake. Overnight at Crater Lake Lodge, then head to the Hwy of the Waterfalls. Along the route to Roseburg, pass 13 waterfalls and amazing photo opportunities. Relax and overnight in Roseburg, then head back to Portland. What a trip! Fourteen days of unforgettable experiences!
